




Germana De Ruvo Italy



Joele Anastasi, born in Catania in 1989, is a Sicilian actor, director, and playwright. After studying at the International Musical Academy of Catania, he moved to Rome to attend the Link Academy. In 2013, he founded the theatre company Vucciria Teatro, making his debut as a director and playwright with the play "lo, mai niente con nessuno avevo fatto". He continues to work in theatre and performance art, with a particular focus on contemporary playwriting.





Mario Costanzi (Genoa, 1963) is an Italian singer-songwriter, producer, and priest. Active since 1980, he has written over 250 songs, ranging from singer-songwriter music to ambient electronic compositions. He is the founder of the SUONAMIDITE Association and manages the artistic center Mulino del Ronzone in Vinci. His work also includes narrative music therapy projects for people with Alzheimer's, which have received national and international recognition.





A Lebanese international storyteller with over 20 years of experience, she began her career inspired by her grandmother. Holding a Master's and PhD in storytelling and education, she brought storytelling to TV and radio. She conducts workshops worldwide and serves as a jury member at storytelling festivals.



Fidaa Ataya Palestine

Fidaa is the heart of Seraj Libraries and the House of Stories: a Palestinian NGO established in 2005 that supports communities by creating libraries and cultural centers. The organization preserves and brings Palestinian stories and narratives to life through art and performances, fostering cultural connections and promoting storytelling across generations. Fidaa is a fiery performer, whose energy is sure to captivate, move, and transform the heart of her audience.





Born and raised in Gaza, Alham is a living library of memory for her people. Deeply connected to the oral tradition of her land, she is currently attending the "Art of Storytelling Academy" in Ramallah to enhance her technique through the artistic language of storytelling revival. Alham tells stories to preserve and celebrate the oral tradition of Palestine.

Sef Townsend is a London-based storyteller with over 30 years of experience, renowned for his work in peace and reconciliation. He has performed in diverse settings, including refugee camps, schools, and religious institutions worldwide. He was honored as Storytelling Ambassador by the International Academy for Intangible Cultural Heritage in 2024.





Shereen Saif is an Indian-born, UAE-raised multidisciplinary artist whose work spans classical dance, theatre, and storytelling. Marie-Georges Giboyau is a storyteller from Martinique. Born in Saint-Joseph, she began her career as a teacher and speech therapist, later transitioning into storytelling. She is renowned for blending French and Martinican Creole in her performances, often recounting tales from her grandfather, Papa Fofo. Her storytelling is celebrated for its cultural richness and its ability to captivate audiences of all ages.





Giovanna Cavasola, known as "The Weaver of Stories," is an oral storyteller, actress, and puppeteer born in Italy and residing in Mexico since 1990. A pioneer of oral storytelling in Mexico, she has blended Italian and Mexican narrative traditions in her repertoire. She has participated in international festivals and led workshops in a variety of settings, including hospitals, schools, and museums. She has also performed stories at cultural institutions such as the National Museum of Art and the Elena Garro Cultural Center.





A Tunisian theater artist and storyteller, and the director of the Storytellers' Tour at the Carthage International Monodrama Festival, he has been working for years on Tunisian and international heritage by presenting storytelling shows and facilitating specialized workshops for children and youth. Enedina Sanna Italy


